

**APPLICATION TO THE SOUTHERN SURGICAL ASSOCIATION  
FOR A SCHOLARSHIP IN THE HISTORY OF MEDICINE**

(Deadline – July 1, 2008 for presentation in 2009)

The Southern Surgical Association has approved an annual scholarship to support a member to pursue a subject in the history of medicine. The subject may relate to an individual, a place, an event or the development of scientific information leading to a mechanical device. The application should be submitted to the Secretary of the Southern Surgical Association for review by the Scholarship Committee. If accepted, an abstract for review by the Program Committee is expected to result from the work. If the abstract is accepted, a manuscript will be submitted at the time of presentation for peer review by the Editorial Board of the *Journal of the American College of Surgeons* for approval for publication. The paper should be presented by the member. The period of study can be carried out at the library or institution of choice of the scholar. Financial support for this study will be available from the Joseph M. Donald Endowment for the Archival Collection of the Southern Surgical Association and be given to the member at the time of presentation at the meeting. All manuscripts submitted for publication should indicate the support of the Joseph M. Donald Archival Collection and Endowment Fund of the Southern Surgical Association.
